



WHAT TO EXPECT IF YOU ARE ELECTED:

The Board of Trustees--

To serve for three (3) years, and approximately one-third of the Trustees shall be elected each year. You may serve as many terms as you choose.

To gather with the members of the Board and elect a Chair or co-Chairs; one shall represent the Board on the Administrative Council.

To make such rules and regulations as it may deem appropriate for the maintenance and improvement of the church property. The Board may choose to work through the Building Use Committee and Bethlehem staff to accomplish this task.

To act to maintain adequate insurance on the property of the Congregation; to authorize the purchase, rent or lease of all equipment and/or services necessary for the efficient operation of the Congregation, and, to supervise and direct the work of maintaining the church property.

To oversee or supervise the maintenance workers of the Congregation.
